

Guide for Connecting to the Wireless Network For Students and Staff using laptops not supplied by ITSU

- / You **MUST** have your **DET username and password** to connect to the wireless.
- / If you forget your password or you have any problems please contact the **Student Administration office or Library for assistance**

Preparation

When preparing to connect to the wireless network, please ensure you:

- / Fully read through this document.
- / Record and save all the previous information that you are changing on your laptop. This will include when changing your network connection settings and changing pop-up settings.

How to Log on to the Sydney Institute Wireless

Logon to the windows desktop

1. Please turn over the page and follow the instructions to Configure the Proxy address settings to <http://pac.det.nsw.edu.au/det/wireless.pac> within Internet Explorer 7 and Mozilla Firefox 3.
2. Connect to the '**SydneyInstitute**' wireless network using the Microsoft wireless connection procedure.
3. Open the web browser and authenticate with your **DET** portal username – followed by **@DET** if you are a DET staff member or **@EDU** if you are a student – and password. A new browser window with a logout link will pop-up.
4. If you wish to access the internet while connected you will be required to authenticate again using your **DET Portal username and password** – this will occur as a separate pop-up request or through the DET Portal web site.

Disconnecting

1. When you have finished your session on the wireless network, log out using the link in the Logout browser window.
2. If you wish to connect to another network or internet connection (i.e. At home) you will need to recover your original network connection settings that may have been changed when you connected to the Sydney Institute wireless network.

Troubleshooting

If your internet browser appears to 'freeze up' after authentication to the wireless network, try closing it, restarting your computer and connecting again.

Internet Explorer V7**How to add a proxy address in Internet Explorer v7:**

1. Open **Internet Explorer**
2. Click **Tools – Internet Options**
3. Click on the **Connections** Tab
4. Click **LAN Settings**
5. Tick **'use automatic configuration script'**
6. Add the following proxy in the address line:

7. Click **Ok**

If you have the **'disable pop-ups'** feature enabled in your internet browser, you will need to:

1. Open **Internet Explorer**
2. Click **Tools**.
3. Select **Pop up Blocker – Pop up Blocker Settings**
4. In the 'Address of website to allow' field enter the following address:
securelogin.arubanetworks.com
5. Click **'Add'** and then Click on **'Close'**

Mozilla Firefox v3**How to add a proxy address in Mozilla Firefox v3:**

1. Open **Mozilla Firefox v3**
2. Click **Tools – Options**
3. Click on the **Advanced Icon**
4. Click on the **Network** Tab
5. Click **Settings**
6. At the Bottom tick **Automatic proxy configuration URL**, enter the following address:

7. Click **Ok**

If you have the **'disable pop-ups'** feature enabled in your internet browser, you will need to:

1. Open **Mozilla Firefox v3**
2. Click **Tools - Options**
3. Select the **Contents** icon
4. Click on the **Exceptions** button that corresponds with the **'Block popup windows'** option.
5. In the 'Address of website' field enter the following address:
securelogin.arubanetworks.com.
6. Click **Allow**.
